It is unique comprehensive care program that offers transportation, medical services, day care activities, some meals, and in-home support as needed by older adults who are getting frail or in need of coordinated assistance. Medicare/Medicaid funding supports this service model as an effective alternative to nursing home care. The Center is staffed with a multidisciplinary team who deliver care for each client base on personalized weekly plans.
